SIX THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

FIRST, You need to be saved: "For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God." (Rom. 3:23) "Except a man be born again he cannot see the Kingdom of God." (John 3:3)

SECOND, You cannot save yourself: "Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us." (Titus 3:5)

THIRD, Jesus has provided for your salvation: "Who (Jesus) His own self bare our sins in His body on the tree, that we being dead to sins should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed." (1 Peter 2:24) "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

FOURTH, You must accept Jesus for salvation: "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved." (Acts 16:31) "But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name."
